ARTICLE II. LICENSE

Sec. 10-16 Required

No person shall engage in the trade or business of auctioneer without first obtaining a license therefor as provided in this article.

Sec. 10-17 Certification of Public Safety Director.

No license shall be issued under this article except upon certification of the Public Safety Director.

Sec. 10-18 Bond

Before any license is issued under this article, the applicant therefor shall furnish a corporate surety bond in the sum prescribed in section 21-24 with sufficient surety to be approved by the city clerk, which bond shall be conditioned for the due observance during the time of the license of all laws of the state and all ordinance of the city. Any person aggrieved by the action of any such licensee shall have a right of action on the bond for the recovery of money or damages, or both. Such bond shall remain in full force and effect for a period of ninety (90) days after the expiration or cancellation of any such license or after the termination of any action upon such bond.
