

CHAPTER 17.8 FUMIGATION

Sec. 17.8-1 Permit required

No person, firm or corporation shall use or engage in the business of using any poisonous gas or gases that are dangerous to the health or safety of human life, for the purpose of fumigation, destruction of vermin or otherwise without having first procured a permit from the city clerk so as to do and then only in conformity with such permit, and further pay the permit fee to the city clerk as provided by section 21-24. (Ord. of 7-19-82)

Sec. 17.8-2 License required

Any person, firm or corporation desiring to use or engage in the business of using poisonous gases in the city shall make application to the city clerk for annual licensing and shall pay the annual licensing fee as provided in section 21-24. (Ord. of 7-19-72)

Sec. 17.8-3 Bond required

Before any such license is issued, the applicant therefore shall furnish a corporate surety bond in the penal sum specified in section 21-24 with sufficient surety to be approved by the city clerk, which bond shall be conditioned for the due observance during the time of the license of all laws of the state and all applicable provisions of the City Code. Any person aggrieved by the action of any such licensee shall have a right of action on the bond for the recovery of money or damages, or both. Such bond shall remain in full force and effect for a period of ninety (90) days after the expiration or cancellation of any such license or after the termination of any action upon such bond.
