1. All vendors/peddlers operating in the city limits of Benton Harbor must be licensed by the City of Benton Harbor and have the license visible at all times.
2. All vendors/peddlers must have a valid driver's license or state issued I.D. Failure to provide the City with the required documentation, will subject the City to deny your request for an application for participation in this special event.
3. All vendors/peddlers cooking and selling food must obtain a license from the Berrien County Health Department.
4. ALL vendors and /or peddlers operating serving food within the City of Benton Harbor must have personal liability insurance in the amount of \$100,000.00.
5. All vendors/peddlers must be off the parade route by 12:45 p.m. and shall not consume alcohol beverages during the parade.
6. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
7. Falsifying your application will result in your application being denied.

**VIOLATIONS OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN THE IMMEDIATE REVOCATION OF ANY AND ALL CITY LICENSES, WHICH MAY RESULT IN THE DENIAL OF ANY FUTURE LICENSE.**
