TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS, AND INDIVIDUALS:

NOTICE is given that a public input is being sought for the development and creation of the PY2022 Annual Action Plan for the City of Benton Harbor's Community Development Block Grant Program. Initial input will be pursued for a 30-day period beginning May 1, 2022.

The Annual Action Plan identifies projects eligible for expenditure of funds from the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) during the program year (PY2022) from July, 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Annual Allocation Expected: \$410,000- All proposed activities' budgets will be proportionally increased or decreased from the estimated funding levels to match actual allocation amounts.

Projects for the PY2022 year include:

1. Housing Rehabilitation Program \$172,500
2. Homeownership Program \$80,000
3. Public Services for Low to Moderate Income Individuals \$67,500 (not to exceed 15% of annual allocation)
4. Program Administration: \$90,000 (not to exceed 20% of annual allocation)
