2022 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD & PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE is given that a draft of the Program Year (PY) 2022 Annual Action Plan (AAP) for the City of Benton Harbor will be available for a thirty (30) day public comment period. Notice is also given that a Public Hearing will be held to review and discuss the proposed AAP.

The PY 2022 AAP outlines proposed projects and activities by the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to address the identified priority needs and goals of the Consolidated Plan. The City expects to receive an estimated \$411,037 in CDBG funding from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) for the 2022 program year, which begins July 1, 2022 and ends June 30, 2023. Projects for PY 2022 include:

Administration (20%): \$82,207
Public Services (15%): \$61,656
Housing Rehabilitation Program: \$267,174

Public Comment Period: A 30-day comment period is scheduled to begin on May 20, 2022 and end on June 20, 2022. The proposed plan will be available to view at the Community & Economic Development Department, City Hall, 200 E.
