

**NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE
GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022
CITY OF BENTON HARBOR**

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF BENTON HARBOR:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Benton Harbor who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk, the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 24, 2022**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.497) at the City Clerk's office, located at 200 E. Wall Street, Benton Harbor, MI 49022 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday – Friday from 8:30am to 12:30pm and 1:30pm to 5:00pm
- Saturday, November 5, 2022 from 7:00am to 3:00pm
- Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022 from 7:00am to 8:00pm

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following offices will appear on the ballot:

Governor & Lieutenant Governor; Secretary of State; Attorney General; Representative in Congress 4th District; State Senator 20th District; Representative in State Legislature 38th District; State Board of Education; University of Michigan Regents; Michigan State University Trustees; Wayne State University Governors; County Commissioner 4th District; Justice of the Supreme Court; 3rd District Court of Appeals; 2nd Circuit Court Judge; 5th District Court Judge; Lake Michigan College Board of Trustees; Benton Harbor Area School Board Members.

As well as, three (3) State Proposals and a Berrien County Public Safety Millage.

Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the local clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot.
