PUBLIC COMMENT REVIEW PERIOD & PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE is given that a Substantial Amendment to the Program Year (PY) 2022 Annual Action Plan (AAP) and to the Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) for the use of Federal U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) funds for Benton Harbor will be available for a thirty (30) day public comment and review period. Notice is also given that a Public Hearing will be held.

2022 AAP SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT & CPP AMENDMENT

The City will make a substantial amendment to the 2022 AAP to reallocate funds from existing projects and add a public infrastructure improvement goal and project. Planned activities under the public service project were also amended. The CPP will be amended to define future substantial amendments and minor amendments.

Public Comment Period: A 30-day public comment period will be held to allow for the public to review and make comments on the draft 2022 AAP Substantial Amendment. The public comment period will be held from December 30, 2022 to January 30, 2023. The Substantial Amendment will be posted on the City website at <https://bhcity.us/community-economic-development/> and at the Benton Harbor Public Library as well as CEDD, City Hall, 200 E. Wall Street, Benton Harbor, MI. Written comments could be submitted to the CEDD at the address above or via email to alittle@bhcity.us.

Public Hearing: The City will hold a public hearing to review the draft Substantial Amendment on January 18, 2023 at 5:30 PM at the Personnel and Finance Committee Meeting. City Commission meetings are held at City Hall, 200 E. Wall Street, Benton Harbor, MI in the Commission Chamber.

Accessibility: In accordance to the ADA of 1990, all persons with a disability who need accommodations to participate could contact the Director of CEDD by phone or email. All non-English speaking persons who need translation services could also contact the Director of CEDD by phone or email. The City will upon request with seven (7) calendar days' notice, provide interpreter services at the public meeting. The public hearing held at the Lula Lee Commission Chambers at City Hall is ADA accessible. Persons with a disability may also view documents on the website.
