2023 HYDRANT REPLACEMENTS PROJECTADVERTISEMENT TO BID

The **City of Benton Harbor** is seeking bids to complete the 2023 Hydrant Replacements Project.

The project includes removals and replacements of fire hydrants, auxiliary valves, and hydrant leads with all associated removals and replacements of pavement, sidewalk, curb and gutter, restoration, and traffic control at various locations about the city.

Bids shall be made out to **City of Benton Harbor**, 200 E Wall St, Benton Harbor, Michigan 49022, until **10:00 AM** local time on **January 27, 2023** at which time and place said bids will be opened publicly.

Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder and the contract for which the bid is being submitted on the outside of the envelope. All bidders shall bid in accordance with and upon the bid forms included in the contract documents. No bids will be received after the designated time stated above.

Bidders will be required to provide Bid security in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, money order, or a Bid Bond, of a sum no less than *5 percent (5%)* of the total bid amount, made payable to the City of Benton Harbor, as security for the proper execution of the Contract.

The project shall be fully completed no later than **November 3, 2023**. See additional information regarding contract times in the agreement form provided in the bidding documents.

Your Bid will be required to be submitted under a condition of irrevocability for a period of *90 days* after submission.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informality in bidding or to accept the bid, consistent with law, which best serves the interest of the Owner.
